

# Material

The application of our fabric is mostly for shirt and uniform.

#### 1. TC Drill



- Polyester (65%), Cotton (35%)
- 230 g/m2
- Common used in short pants, skorts

TC Drill is a fabric made of both the artificial polyester and the natural cotton. As cotton/polyester composition is 35% of cotton and 65% of polyester. The blend is perfect for clothing as it brings both benefits of the two fabrics together. The fabric thus remains lightness and coolness of the cotton while still adding the strength and durability of the polyester. TC Drill material can be wash easily and show very good breathable and durable properties.

#### 2. Polyester



- Polyester (100%)
- 175 g/m2
- Common used in short pants, skorts

Polyester is a generalised term for any fabric or textile, which is made using polyester yarns or fibres. 100% polyester is no mixing of any cotton material. It is such a popular choice for apparel because polyester fibres are thermoplastic, or heat-sensitive. They are also highly stain-resistant, so great for cleaning. Polyester fabric is easy to look after and it can be washed and dried at home.

#### 3. 20 TC Pique (PK)



- Polyester (65%), Cotton (35%)
- 220 g/m2
- Common used in polo shirt

Pique's weave features cotton yarn characterised by raised parallel cords or fine ribbing. This gives the material a subtle pattern and texture – which can only be seen up close. It's breathable, durable and easily cared for and has excellent give and comfort. Its breathable nature also ensures that any wearers of pique stay cool. Furthermore, the textured weave is great at hiding all those perspiration stains.

#### 4. 26 TC Single Jersey



- Polyester (65%), Cotton (35%)
- 175 g/m2
- Common used in T-shirt

This material is basic fabric and common used in T-shirt. It is light weight, soft & smooth on the skin. It is good sweat absorbent and have quick dry & cool features. Single jersey is best material for outdoor and indoor wear.

#### 5. TC



- Polyester (65%), Cotton (35%)
- 110 g/m2
- Common used in button shirt

TC is Tetoron Cotton as polyester/cotton blended. TC fabrics are welcomed by people because of their excellent strength, durability, wrinkle resistance, high color fastness and good hygiene characteristics. It is often used for button shirt. TC material has good water absorption and high durability.




